### Board of Directors Minutes

*Florida Suncoast MG Car Club  
February 4, 1998*

The meeting was called to order at 7:25 p.m. President Jim Alonso called this emergency meeting to review and discuss the proposed revisions to the Club's Bylaws by the Bylaw Review Committee. In attendance were the full Board of Directors and officers.

Bruce explained that the Review Committee carefully looked at all of the sections, updating, correcting grammar & spelling, and making some clarification recommendations. They rewrote the sections that were revised, listing the original Bylaws wording on the left, the revised version on the right, with the reasons for the proposed changes listed in the center. Each section that was revised has a separate approve/disapprove box for voting purposes. The Board of Directors went over each section of the revised proposal, with the Committee answering any questions that arose.

A suggestion was made for the club to write up (a) a Procedure Manual for future officers, listing the duties of the office, (b) an Inventory of what the Club has, and (c) a New Member Packet. This manual would serve as a guideline for the officers to see that the Bylaws are followed.

Jim stated that Jo Ann Hamilton has agreed to be Ballot Chairperson and manage the ballot mailing and tabulation. A brief discussion followed regarding the nominations

of officers for 1999, with a suggestion that the nominees be announced at the September 1998 member meeting and closing at the October 1998 meeting to allow one month to submit a "write in" candidate or ask for any other volunteers.

At the February 11 meeting, the Bylaws Review Committee will make a report on the Bylaw revision proceedings.

Motions were made, seconded, and approved (1) to approve the revisions to the Bylaws, (2) to present the revisions to the Membership for voting, and (3) to provide a budget for printing and postage.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:20 p.m.

*Safety Fast* magazine raffle was won by Bruce Rauch, who received the 3/97 issue.

*Correspondence:* Jim reported that he received a letter from Bloomington, Illinois regarding an MGA Roadster for sale for \$14,900. If anyone is interested in this, contact him. Dave Tietz stated that the club received a press release for an upcoming April 2-5 car show in Charlotte, North Carolina, as well as the registration for the GOF South event in St. Augustine on April 3-5. These will be included in the Newsletter. The Club received brochures from Matthews Foreign Car, other club newsletters, and several membership renewals, which were given to Gail. It was noted that the Jan/Feb, 1998 British Marque reprinted Tom's Jamboree 9 report, *A Real Kool Time!*. The January 1998 Safety Fast issue reprinted Margie Wilgus' article on the *Planes, Trains, and Automobiles* event, including our Club logo.

*Membership:* Glenn reported that the Club has 64 memberships and that there have been several inquiries on the Internet. He mailed Newsletters to those interested parties. He also drafted a letter to be sent to all new members in response to a previous suggestion at a Board of Directors meeting regarding putting together a Welcoming Packet. The Club has membership applications as well as business cards available where you can insert your name & phone number.

#### **Committee Reports:**

*Activities:* In Pat Dwyer's absence, Dave Tietz reported on the next event to be held on Saturday, February, 14 - a tour of the *Titanic Exhibition* in St. Pete followed by dinner at The Moon Under Water restaurant. On Friday, February 13, the club is invited to view the movie *Titanic* together.

Jayne Hemstreet spoke about Earl's upcoming 80th birthday party on March 1st. Invitations were in the January Newsletter. She reminded us that the only requirement is for the guests to wear their favorite MG Shirt.

Margie Wilgus scouted out the beaches of Treasure Island to come up with our next Breakfast Club location, the Bilmar Beach Resort. They will provide a separate room and individual checks for our Club. This will take place on Saturday, March 14 at 9 a.m. Dave Tietz offered to lead the group on one of his famous power walks along the beach after breakfast.

These ballots will be mailed to each Club member. Jo Ann Hamilton, Ballot Chairperson, will handle the ballot mailing & tabulation. All Members are asked to read the cover letter and the revisions carefully.

Tom Jevcak raised a question on why the membership was not made aware of the special Board of Directors meeting. Jim stated that he called an emergency Board Meeting as provided in the Bylaws.

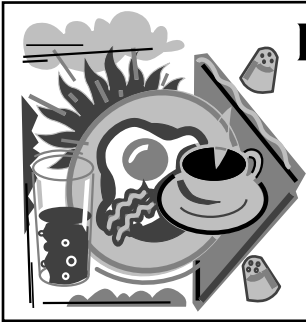
The Club sends sincere condolences to David & Rosemary Knight. Rosemary's mother, Grace Bladon, passed away in England on January 29.

## Tech Tip

Do you have a hydraulic jack? Do you work under your car? Should the unthinkable happen, does your spouse know how to operate the jack? Most hydraulic jacks require a valve to be closed in some manner in order to operate, and it often isn't obvious how it is done. It might be a good idea to review with your better half how the car can be raised if the need arises. This includes the solid jack points on the body and suspension. I have had Dianne give me a demonstration with our jack.

Along the same lines, on a recent visit to my garage, Glenn Lenhard did not give my department store 3-point jack stands very good marks. He recommends 4-point (which are more stable).

Of course everyone knows you never, never, never, never... ever prop up a car on a cement block... right?

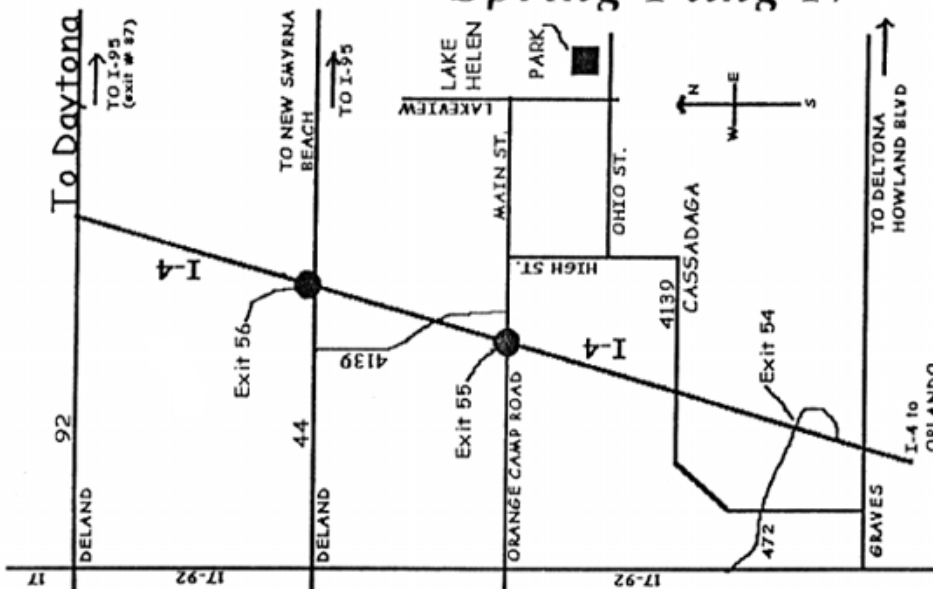

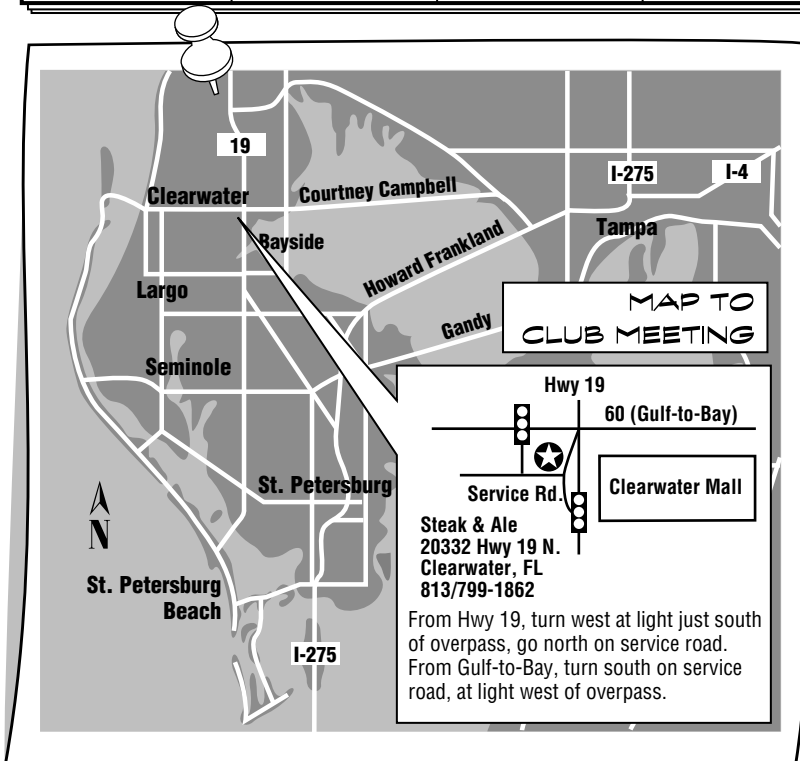

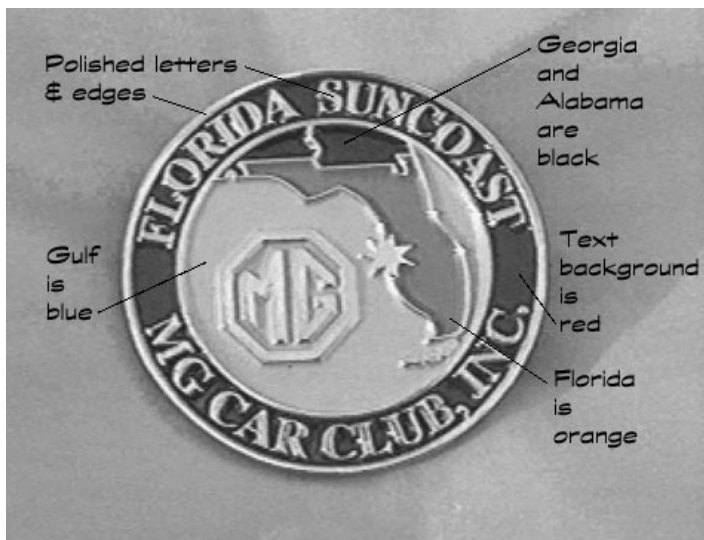
