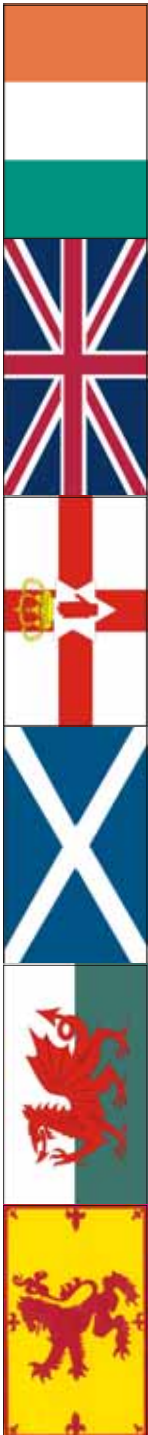

The Vice-President shall assume the duties of the President in his/her absence. Further, the Vice-President shall act as membership coordinator reporting on membership applicants at each monthly meeting, create a member-ship plan for his/her term of office and publish an annual roster of members.

The Secretary shall take and maintain a written record of all meetings, take roll, make a report of the minutes of any meetings when requested and conduct the correspondence of the Club.

The Treasurer shall keep an accurate account of all financial transactions of the Club, submit a verbal financial report at each monthly meeting and submit a written financial report at each quarterly Board of Directors meeting or when requested by The Board of Directors.
